Omnipod[®] NDSS Subsidy



Am I eligible?

The Omnipod NDSS subsidy will be available on 1 December 2022. You can access the subsidy if:

- 1. You are living with type 1 diabetes and registered with the NDSS
- 2. You lodge the NDSS Insulin Pump Consumables Access Form, certified by your diabetes health professional nominating Omnipod as your insulin pump.
- 3. You have been registered as a Omnipod DASH System User by one of these pathways:



Without Private Health Insurance

You will need to purchase a no lock-in subscription payable to Omnipod Australia for a monthly cost of \$168.27 to access the Omnipod DASH System, providing eligibility to NDSS subsidised Pods* as a registered Omnipod user.

^{*}Access to subsidised Pods conditional to Podding payments being met. The NDSS co-payment amount is \$29.30/box for general & \$22.20/box for concession card holders.

With Private Health Insurance

Check with your insurer about your eligibility to access Omnipod DASH System. Once approved, your insurer will cover the cost to access the Omnipod DASH System, providing eligibility to NDSS subsidised Pods as a registered Omnipod user.

The NDSS co-payment amount is \$29.30/box for general & \$22.20/box for concession card holders.

How do I access my Pods?

Once you have met the criteria and have received training on Omnipod DASH System, you will be able to access your Pods through an NDSS Access Point near you.
